Art Spectrum® Colourfix™ Papers are sheets of acid-free, 300gsm hot pressed European watercolour paper, screen printed with Art Spectrum® Colourfix™ Primer making a 340gsm pastel paper. The range has 20 lightfast colours, available in both Medium and Smooth. It is a superb substrate for pastel and most mediums.

The natural, toothy surface will hold multiple layers of pastel without the need for fixative, allowing the velvet bloom and vibrant colour of pastels to be preserved.

Erasing is also easy with Colourfix[™] – simply lift off excess pastel with clear adhesive tape, brush off with a dry brush, or use a pencil eraser. Alternatively, errors can be overpainted or areas touched up with the matching colour of Art Spectrum Colourfix[™] Primer. The tough, toothy surface can be sanded, scrubbed, soaked and reworked over and over.
